Best Practices for Your RV Rental Listing

- 1. **Photos, photos,** and more **photos** are key to a great RV rental listing.
- **2.** Your listing **headline** serves to capture a renter's attention and will help them decide if they want to read more.
- **3.** Your listing **description** should include all of the details about your RV and its amenities.
- **4.** You should also include local <u>attractions</u> in your listing description.

| Listing Rules

- **1.** Each RV rental platform gives you the opportunity to set your own <u>rules</u> that determine how, when, and at what price people can book your RV.
- **2.** Try to set a price that's in the **middle** of the price range for similar RV rentals in your area.
- **3.** Depending on the value of your rig, security deposits can range from **\$500** to **\$1,500** or more.
- **4.** The RV rental platform will let you choose the type of **cancellation policy** (flexible or strict) that you want.

Other Listing Options

- 1. <u>Add-ons</u> like bikes, generators, s'more kits, airport pick-up/drop-offs, and other features can be great ways to earn extra money and add more value for your guests.
- **2.** Most RV rental platforms have a built-in **system** where you can create add-ons and set daily or one-time pricing.
