Step 4: The Final Step

Congrats, you've made it to the final step. Getting organized takes some time upfront but once you have your organizational systems in place, it's just a matter of maintaining them.

Each item in your RV now has a home. When you use an item, or if you find something sitting out, you know where it belongs. It's much easier to stay organized by establishing a habit of always returning an item to its designated place. Packing up on travel days is also a much quicker process when everything is already put away.

If you do have items without a home, now is the time to create a drop zone.

Creating a Drop Zone

A drop zone is a temporary place to store loose items until they're placed in a permanent location. The drop zone should consist of a small container, preferably with a lid, so you don't create a habit of putting everything in there.

Now that loose items are put away in the drop zone and all of your items have a home, you're officially organized.







Step 4: The Final Step

As you continue to travel in your RV, you may want to change some things around-that's totally fine. The key to staying organized is building the habit of giving everything a home. If you use something, return it to its place when you're done. If you buy something new, find a designated area for that item, or practice the one-in-one-out method and donate something you already own.
