#### Cochiti Recreation Area in New Mexico

- **@** Cochiti Recreation Area
- Pena Blanca, New Mexico
- ★ Get a taste of New Mexico's desert landscape and surrounding mountains in this campground, located west of Santa Fe. Some loops have water and electric sites that accommodate RVs.

## McKinney Campground in Georgia

- **McKinney Campground**
- O Acworth, Georgia
- ★ Located on Allatoona Lake, this popular campground has plenty of water for recreation, wooded sites, and views of Georgia's rolling hills.

## W.P. Franklin Campground in Florida

- **W.P. Franklin Campground**
- O Near Fort Myers, Florida
- ★ Fort Myers is a popular Florida destination, known for its Gulf beaches. This campground gives you a tropical atmosphere and direct water access to the Caloosahatchee River.
